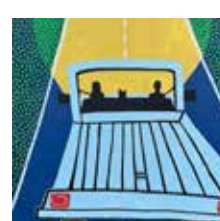

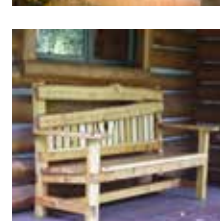

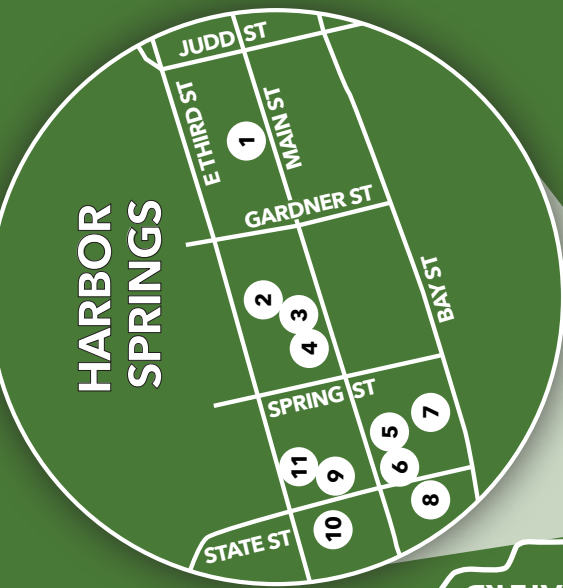

In celebration of the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence, the Good Hart Artist Residency will honor the vibrant artistic legacy of this region.

Bringing together past and present, the Tunnel of Trees Art Trail will highlight the continuity of artistic expression in Northwest Lower Michigan, from Odawa art, to the Chippawa Cove Woods artist colony of Ivan Swift, to contemporary work created within the local community today. Long before 1776, Odawa artists were shaping a rich visual and cultural landscape grounded in deep relationships to land, community, and storytelling.

During the art trail, visitors can explore the rich history of art in this region on posters at the Good Hart Artist Residency. Indigenous art and culture are featured at the Harbor Springs History Museum, Thorne Swift Nature Preserve, and the King House, as well as through works presented by individual Odawa artists along the art trail. Please join us in this celebration of art.

The Good Hart Artist Residency offers 10- to 21-day residencies to visual artists, writers, and composers, selected through a juried process. The residency works in partnership with several local nonprofit organizations to connect visiting artists with the community.
